

Hiring Process

We would like to first thank your interest in Washington County EMS. The process is every changing to give you the best opportunity to be successful. The process if in three parts.

- Written Exam
 - The written exam is composed of National Registry standard. You as an applicant will take the test based on your certification level. You have to pass the exam to make it to the next level.
- Physical Agility
 - The physical agility is broken up into two different portions.
 - First portion is the 1.5 mile run/walk. This portion is a timed event. It is important to give you best.
 - Second portion is three different skill stations.
 - Two flights of stairs with our trauma bag
 - Carry a backboard manikin 50 meters to a stretcher. Secure manikin to the stretcher and maneuver stretcher to the waiting ambulance. After stretcher is loading into ambulance. You will perform two minutes of CPR on a manikin. (Two minutes of CPR does not count toward overall time)
 - You will carry a jump bag 25 meter to an ATV. Perform a rapid extrication of manikin from ATV and pull manikin 25 meters.
 - All three skill stations will have a combine total time.

- You will be given a score on you run/walk time and the three skill stations.
