P1 Status Paramedics Do NOT have unrestricted access of protocols and must have a P2 on scene to perform the following procedures:

- Rapid Sequence Intubation
- Induction of Hypothermia
- Facility Bypass Protocols
- Pain Management
- No Patient Transport
- Treat and Release

A P2 must be present or direct online medical director consultation prior to performing the above procedures. The P1 process is approximately 250 hrs of training / education.
